

PACKING LIST

Travel essentials

- Pack lightly.
Only one check-in luggage is allowed (maximum weight is 23 kg, or 50 lbs). In addition you are allowed one piece of hand baggage plus a laptop or handbag.
- Passport: make sure it is valid at least 90 days after departing from Prague (carry 2 extra copies of the picture page, pack separately)
- Electronic air ticket (it will be mailed to you before departure)
- Insurance card
(you must carry a medical insurance to enter the Czech Republic)
- Student ID if relevant (discount at certain sites)
- Emergency contacts
- Spending money for one meal a day and pocket money for souvenirs (\$150- \$200)
- ATM card & credit card (travelers' checks are NOT recommended)
- Earplugs/eye mask

Festival essentials

- Black music folder
- Music (there will be no possibility of replacement in Prague)
- Several pencils, sharpener and eraser
- Water bottle marked with your name
- Concert attire:
Women - black formal dress, black stockings and black shoes, skirt length below the knees. Black formal pants with black formal top are ok. No sleeveless top, please. Short sleeves are fine.
Men - black formal pants and black formal shoes, black socks, black formal shirt with long sleeves, and solid color long neck tie (no bow tie, no tuxedo, no tails).

Outfits - Personal clothing for one week in Prague

- Light sweater

- Shorts
- Raincoat or umbrella

- Washcloth
- Alarm clock/watch
- Inflatable travel pillow
- Sewing kit & safety pins
- Detergent
- Travel iron
- Blow dryer (with 110-220V converter)
- Money and passport pouch
- Ziploc bags
- Guide books and maps (optional)
- Personal journal (optional)
- Address book
- Camera, memory card, extra batteries
- Voltage convertor and plug adaptor for your electronic devices
- Small day pack
- Luggage tags
